Certificate IV in Accounting and Bookkeeping



Career Training Institute (CTI) is offering a 2023 enrolment opportunity for students wishing to further their career opportunities by undertaking FNS40222 Certificate IV in Accounting and Bookkeeping.

This qualification reflects the role of individuals in the accounting and bookkeeping industry, including business activity statement (BAS) agents and contract bookkeepers; and of those employees performing bookkeeping tasks for organisations in a range of industries. It includes preparing and lodging business and instalment activity statements, data processing, monthly reconciliations, preparing budgets, preparing reports on financial performance and the position of the business, preparing end-of-year adjustments, and finalising financial records after year-end. Individuals in these roles apply theoretical and specialist skills and knowledge to work autonomously, and exercise judgement in completing tasks.

Course structure

To graduate from this course, students are required to complete thirteen units: ten core units plus three electives. The following units in this course have been selected by CTI after investigation informed by engagement with industry.

This qualification is currently cited as meeting the TPB education requirements for registration as a BAS agent. Persons seeking BAS agent registration should check current registration requirements with the TPB, as registration requirements are reviewed regularly.

Entry requirements

There are no specific entry requirements, but it is expected that students will have the ability and aptitude commensurate with completing a secondary school education.

On enrolment, students will be given access to their course on the CTI Learning Management System. Prior to course commencement students are required to complete a Language, Literacy and Numeracy test. Pending the result of this test, the student will be permitted to continue to the course. It is strongly recommended this is completed before course commencement in February.

Duration

The course is designed to be completed over a period of 15 months.

For the 2023 enrolment intake, the student has until 30 June 2024 to complete the course, which allows some flexibility. A schedule for the completion of each unit will be established by CTI, and it is expected that students will commit to comply with this schedule.

If the course is not completed by the end of the enrolment period, the student will be required to enrol for an additional period at full new enrolment cost.

Course Fees

The total cost of enrolment in FNS40222 Certificate IV in Accounting and Bookkeeping in 2023 is \$2,925.00

This enrolment will conclude on 30 June 2024.

Course fees are GST free.

Clients will be charged 50% (\$1,462.50) at course commencement and will be charged for the remaining 50% (\$1,462.50) after six months.

Textbooks are required and will be supplied by CTI at an additional cost of \$550.00 (incl. GST). This is a compulsory levy.
